**FEDERAL AGENTS DO NOT HAVE
CONSENT TO ENTER THIS PRIVATE AREA
WITHOUT PERMISSION OR A VALID
JUDICIAL WARRANT.**

STAFF DO NOT HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO GRANT ACCESS.

**EVERY JUDICIAL WARRANT MUST BE SIGNED BY A JUDGE AND
SAY "U.S. DISTRICT COURT" OR A STATE COURT AT THE TOP.**

We will not do more than is legally required by an administrative warrant:
administrative warrants (forms I-200 or I-205) are not from a court; administrative warrants DO NOT give
agents the right to enter private areas without our permission; we DO NOT have to say if an employee is
working on that day or not; we will video or record ANY actions federal agents take at this workplace.
