As a note, all the digital resources linked below are stable links. That means that even if the links to the digital documents/resources themselves change, the links to the folders they live in will not. We will eventually also add resources translated into other languages into these folders.

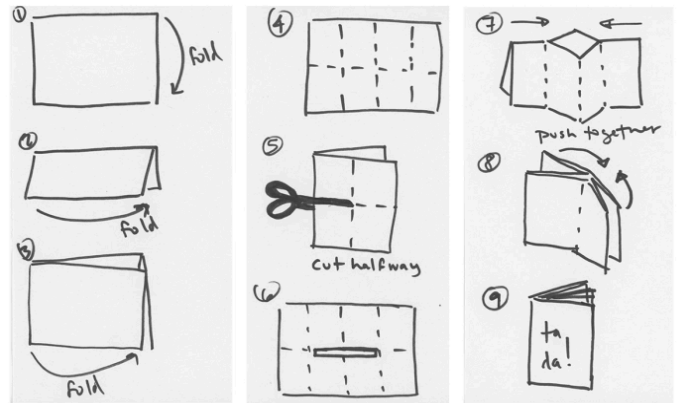
To create an ICE Ready Kit, add the items listed below to a plastic sandwich bag. See the second page of this document for additional information about printing at libraries, 3D printing, and how to order red cards.

1. Know Your Rights “Red Card”

- These cards are bilingual (English/Spanish).
- You can use the [PDF linked in this folder to print red cards](#). It's a two-page PDF that you print as a double-sided handout. Then cut the printed handout up into individual red cards.

2. We Keep Us Safe Foldable Zine

- This zine is bilingual (English/Spanish).
- Printing instructions: Use the [PDF linked in this folder](#). It's a one-page PDF. Then fold and cut the zine to create an 8-page booklet. Video instructions: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1kiqwTfy0fA>.
- We find it works well to place the back cover of the zine (with the whistle information) facing out in the sandwich baggie, as it's bilingual and gives folks a clear indication of what kind of information the kit contains.



3. Resources QR Code Quarter Sheets

- These immigration resource QR codes are bilingual (English on one side, Spanish on the other).

4. Aurora Unidos CSO “How to Identify ICE” Quarter Sheets

5. OPTIONAL: A whistle!

- If you're able to add a key ring or a lanyard, that's ideal!
- **Not all immigrant communities prefer to use whistles as an ICE alert system. Check with your local leaders, organizations, and individuals with immigrant communities to ensure they consent to the use of whistles.**
