

HOW TO RECORD ICE

- FOOTAGE IS **EVIDENCE**
- **BRIEFLY NARRATE FOOTAGE WITH THE LOCATION, THE TIME, AND WHAT HAPPENED BEFORE THE RECORDING STARTED**
- **HOLD YOUR PHONE HORIZONTALLY, AT A **SAFE DISTANCE**, & VISIBLE TO ICE**
- **DO NOT SHARE FOOTAGE PUBLICLY WITHOUT CONSENT.**



STAY NONVIOLENT. DON'T STAY SILENT.

IF YOU SEE ICE AND ARE AT HIGHER RISK OF BEING DETAINED, STAY INSIDE. YOUR SAFETY IS THE PRIORITY.

IF YOU ARE NOT AT HIGHER RISK, FORM A CROWD AND PROTECT YOUR COMMUNITY:

- CALL CORRN: **844-864-8341**
- RECORD I.C.E.
- **WARN OTHERS**
- **ASK THE PERSON BEING DETAINED FOR THE PHONE # OF A TRUSTED CONTACT.**

e.g. "6 men"

ACTIONS/ACTIVITY: WHAT ARE THEY DOING?
e.g. "At Cheeseman Park in cars and outside of cars, talking to each other"

L

LOCATION: ADDRESS OR CROSS STREETS
(also include direction they are moving if known)
e.g. At corner of Cheeseman Park and E. 10th Ave, Denver

U

UNIFORMS/CLOTHES: LOOK FOR IDENTIFYING ABBREVIATIONS
e.g. "Wearing ballistic vests labeled DHS"

T

TIME/DATE
e.g. "10:05am, November 5"

E

EQUIPMENT/WEAPONS
e.g. "2 people with zip ties on belts, at least 4 are armed, 2 black SUVs, no identifying markings on cars"

I WANT TO HELP KEEP MY IMMIGRANT NEIGHBORS SAFE - WHAT CAN I DO?

- Report ICE sightings and activities to trusted organizations. Do this in Colorado by calling the Colorado Rapid Response hotline. This helps alert vulnerable immigrants so they can avoid interactions with ICE.
- Use the SALUTE protocol (pages 3-4) to collect key details. This ensures that reports are clear, specific, and verifiable by community organizers.
- Be accurate and cautious. Avoid spreading fear by mistaking police or other city agencies for ICE. DO NOT post unverified sightings on social media.

IF YOU WITNESS SOMEONE BEING DETAINED BY ICE

If possible, politely ask the detained person for the **Phone Number** of a person you can contact.

This can help notify the family and provide emotional and legal support.

Write everything down.

Record the information clearly and accurately. This information is important for immigration lawyers and support organizations to locate and assist the person in custody. Do your best.



If you see ICE, make NOISE (blow a whistle, use a megaphone, bang a pan, shout) so people know ICE is present.

SOME OTHER THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:

- Don't discuss activism while observing, photographing or recording ICE.
- Don't post photos or videos on social media that show the faces of people being detained.
- As part of our goal to keep our neighbors safe, we want to make ICE feel uncomfortable and to send a clear message that they are not welcome in our communities. Observing, photographing, and recording them is a powerful way to show resistance. The more visible and unwelcome their presence becomes, the less desirable it will be to work for ICE - making it harder for them to carry out arrests.
